PORTLAND'S TIPPED WORKERS AGREE: VOTE NO ON QUESTION D

What would this ballot question do?

Misleadingly described as an increase in the minimum wage, this ballot question would upend the tipping system valued by servers and bartenders. Research from Cornell and Harvard shows that tips would suffer and jobs would decline.

Do restaurant workers support Question D?

No. In fact, most restaurant workers oppose this ballot question. In 2016, a similar ballot question was rolled back by a bipartisan vote in the state legislature after thousands of restaurant workers rallied against it.

Are there better ways to raise the minimum wage?

Yes. The Portland City Council can raise the minimum wage while preserving the tipped wage system valued by the city's workers.
